- 1. No one will be admitted to the staging area until checked in at the registration booth.
- 2. All animals must be on a leash or otherwise restrained.
- 3. **<u>PLEASE!</u>** All horse units must provide a pooper-scooper following their entry.
- 4. Parade entrants must be on time for line-up, 8 a.m.-9:45 a.m.

- 5. Any violation of the parade rules will result in removal from the parade.
- 6. All motorized vehicles must be driven by a licensed participant.
- 7. We reserve the right to refuse participation to any group or individual.

The HORSE STAGING AREA HAS BEEN RELOCATED

to the first driveway of Anna Classick Bicentennial Park (619 Pine Street) parking lot. Park your vehicle(s) in the designated area of the park parking lot and ride your horse to the Rogue River Shopping Center to check in for the parade. You will then wait in the usual grassy area until the parade begins. Once you have gone through the parade, proceed to the park parking lot where your vehicle is located.
