City Council Update

The Mayor with the City Council spent their September workshop time working on creating an Ordinance establishing a marijuana and marijuana-infused product tax. Anyone interested in reviewing the proposed Ordinance can do so at City Hall. This item will be placed on the October 23rd City Council meeting agenda. In March of this year the City Council passed a moratorium to allow them time to decide their next step in regards to the placement of medical marijuana dispensaries and their effect on our community. The legalization of recreational marijuana, Ballot Measure 91, will be voted on during the General Election in November.

Their September Council meeting was held a week early due to a conflict with the League of Oregon Cities conference they attended in Eugene. Their agenda for the Council meeting consisted of a Proclamation proclaiming October "Mayor's United to Help Fight Hunger Month."

The Mayor and City Council would like to congratulate the "Rogue River Greenway" on their huge success of the Ride-the-Rogue event.

IT'S THAT TIME AGAIN!!!

Fall is here and with that leaves begin to drop. We will start picking up your leaves on October 20th. This service will continue through February 10, 2014.

Please call 541-582-4401 to schedule a pickup.

This is for LEAVES ONLY, no grass, animal droppings, tree limbs, rocks or household garbage. The City has a leaf vacuum, and would like to utilize that as much as possible. All piles of leaves should be in an area accessible within the reach of the 6 foot vacuum hose,

but not behind fences on the sidewalk or in the gutter.

Please do not rake the leaves into open ditches.

The City will also pick up leaves in bags, and if you need bags, stop by City Hall and pick up some. Remember, if you cannot pick up the bag after you have filled it, it is most likely too heavy for our employees to pick up.

ATTENTION VOTERS:

City Hall is no longer collecting the ballots for all upcoming elections. Jackson County has installed a permanent Ballot Drop-Box in front of the Rogue River Library at 412 East Main Street. The box will be available to the public for depositing Ballots 24-hours a day beginning on October 27, 2014.

October 16, 2014 is the deadline for a new or changing your Voters Registration for the General Election on November 4, 2014. The County Clerk cannot accept postmarked dated forms; your registration must be received by her before closing of business on October 16th.
