## City Council Update

The City Council had a full agenda for the March City Council meeting:

- ◆ Held the first of two public hearings to hear citizens comments regarding amendments to the Zoning Ordinance Variances and Miscellaneous permits.
- ◆ Adopted first reading of an Ordinance amending the Zoning Ordinance Variances and Miscellaneous permits.
- ◆ Adopted a Resolution allowing the citizens of Rogue River to vote on the formation of the Rogue Valley Heritage District.
- ◆ The City Council approved the Mayor's Committee recommendations.
- ◆ Appointed Evan Goeglein as an Alternate to the Planning Commission.
- ◆ Authorized the mayor to sign two agreements with the Rogue Valley Council of Governments for professional grant administration services and a Grant Contract with Oregon Infrastructure Finance Authority of Business Development Department for the Water Master Plan Update Project No. P12019.
- ◆ Adopted the 5-year Capital Plan for fiscal year 2013-2014.
- ◆ Ratified a consensus approving an OLCC application for the Cattlemen's Saloon.
- ◆ Agreed to be a Major Sponsor of the 60th Annual Rooster Crow event.
- ◆ Agreed to be a Sponsor of the Community Recognition Dinner.
- ◆ The Mayor proclaimed April 12, 2013 as the 30th "Arbor Day" urging citizens to plant trees to gladden the heart and promote the well-being of present and future generations.

The City has started taking applications for Rooster Crow Commercial Booths. For 60-years we have been celebrating Roosters Crowing in Rogue River. ## PAVEMENT ASSESSMENT OF CITY STREETS

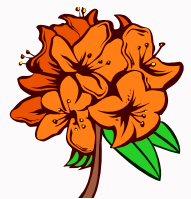
The City has contracted with Capitol Asset & Pavement Services Inc. of Salem to conduct an on-site evaluation and detailed distress rating on all city streets starting April 4, 2013. The consultant will provide the City comprehensive Budget Option Reports at the conclusion of the pavement distress ratings.



These reports will contain all pertinent information relating to the current condition of the city's street network, details of current and future deferred maintenance dollars, future forecasting concerning budget needs, as well as at least four (4) multiple funding scenarios. These reports will also display a street by street breakdown of sections being selected for treatment, with cost associated with each segment. This data will help staff and the City Council prioritize projects to be funded by the recently passed street improvement bond and provide us with a long term pavement maintenance strategy and budget.
