Mayor Wayne Stuart opened the August 2020 City Council meeting asking City Administrator to deliver the invocation then the Mayor asked everyone to join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

After hearing the Committee Reports from the Mayor and City Councilors they made decisions on the following agenda items:

- Adopted a Resolution adopting the Section 3 Plan to comply with 24 CFR, Part 135 of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development Section 3 for the City of Rogue River, Oregon.
- Adopted a Resolution adopting a Limited English Proficiency Plan (LEP) for the City of Rogue River, Oregon.
- Adopted a Resolution adopting Fair Housing in the City of Rogue River, Oregon.
- Adopted a Resolution adopting a Grievance Procedure for Complaints of Alleged Discrimination based on Disability for the City of Rogue River, Oregon.
- Adopted a Resolution adopting a Policy of Nondiscrimination on the Basis of Handicapped Status for the City of Rogue River, Oregon.
- Adopted a Resolution adopting a Oregon Community Development Block Grant Program Excessive Force Policy for the City of Rogue River, Oregon.


