The settings should tell you if the moderator has muted you.

Please limit side conversations, background noise, and multitasking (or snacking) while in the meeting.

Unauthorized remarks from the audience, stamping of feet, whistles, yells, and similar demonstrations shall not be permitted. Disorderly conduct at Council meetings may be prosecuted upon appropriate complaint signed by the presiding officer. The City Hall is handicapped accessible.
