# City Council Update ...



- Mayor VanArsdale opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by an invocation provided by Pastor Lucas Bradburn of Creekside Bible Church. After the City Councilor's gave their committee reports the following items were handled:
- 1 Approved the Mayor's appointment of James Dyck to the Tree City Committee.
- 2 Adopted Ordinance <u>25-439-O</u>, an Ordinance amending Park Rules.
- 3 Approved Resolution <u>25-1456-R</u>, a Resolution updating Council Rules by adding a "Use of City Logo", "Use of City Seal", and "Park Naming Policy".
- 4 Accepted the July 10th Tree City Committee minutes.

- 5 Approved a request from the Wards Creek Restoration Initiative to hang two temporary banners at Rooster Park for 45 days. The banners encourage citizens to sign up for Jackson County's Emergency Alert System.
- 6 Approved Resolution <u>25-1457-R</u> supporting a DLCD grant application from RVCOG.
- 7 Approve Resolution <u>25-1458-R</u> supporting an ODOT grant application for transportation improvement planning related to areas adjacent to the City's I-5 interchange.

See you August 5th at Rooster Park for our 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual National Night Out!


